I've been doing some FPV flying lately. I have an Apprentice 15e and my Parkzone T-28 set up with the video equipment. I did this back in 2008 but the equipment has really improved since then. I've also been playing with some quadcopters. I have to say I have enjoyed them more then I thought I would. I have a Blade 200 QX with the Spektrum Micro-FPV system on it. It is a lot of fun buzzing around at the field and in my neighborhood. It is also a great night flyer! It has some very bright LEDS installed that are excellent at night. I also have a Blade 350 QX3. This is both a sport flier and a camera platform. It carries an E-Flite C-GO1 HD camera that can take stills and video. I've posted some of these on my Facebook page. I've taken some pics of the field and during the last Scout Rocket launch that Derek may put in the newsletter and on the website. The 350 has some flight modes that use GPS and other sensors to make it very easy to do the camera work. It also has a Return Home mode that is really neat to see it work. It brings it right back to the spot it took off from and lands it softly. Pretty neat technology!

What a great time to be in the hobby! I can't wait to see what will be next.
