Four rounds were flown in very pleasant weather, and we were finished by 3:00. It was the end cap to a great season! This year we saw growth in the classic pattern community, great events, and some enthusiastic new pilots.

This year we doubled our lady pilots. Jean Greear flew her Taipan to second place in Pre- Novice class, and Marta Horvath flew her Forte to a third place finish, securing the 2015 Pre-Novice Championship.

Novice class saw a battle between Mike Whitacre and Jonathan Rinde. Jonathan was the 2014 Pre- Novice Champ, and flew to a solid first place, even after having to switch to his backup after a landing gear failure in his primary bird. Mike Whitacre took the second spot, and clinched the Novice championship.

In Advanced, we saw the return of Otto Dieffenbach to pattern after a 37 year absence. Otto flew an electric Kaos to first place. Otto's Kaos features retracting tricycle landing gear, and a Deception stab, with cores given to him by Jim Kimbro back in the 70's. Otto also entertained us with flights with his Snoopy's Flying Dog House, and Superman models. Paul Rinde's consistent flying style earned him a second place contest finish, and the Advanced Championship.

Once again Master's class was the Phoenix vs. Phoenix duel between Tony Frackowiak and Robert Fish, with Tony once again taking the Championship.


