Manny Duarte introduced Dennis Okeefe and Steve Cronk at the March Member Meeting. Both Steve and Dennis are members of of the Kern County Desert Search and Rescue.

The team uses COTS (Commercial Off The Shelf) components for flight controls. The aircraft are fully autonomous using open source software. This incudes a Ground Station which provides real time feedback to the flight crew. This information incudes position, altitude, airspeed and groundspeed. All of the information is telemetered using 900MHz. Additionally, video is transmitted down using a 5.8GHz video link.

Currently, Steve is the only RC pilot for the SAR team. If you are interested in becoming an sUAS pilot, you will need to get certified by the FAA under part 107.
